


#### **Vacations**

#### Planned Absences Other Than School Holidays:

It is the school's philosophy that attendance at school is of primary importance. However, there are times when an absence is unavoidable. In such cases, the parent is to contact the Principal/Administration of the school in advance, whenever possible.
